



AIRPORT COVID-19 TEST DEAL LINKED AKUFFO ADDO *-Contract given to President's Nigerian Billionaire Friend*

Investigations by Whatsup News has revealed that the single sourced award of Ghana's COVID 19 airport test was orchestrated at the highest level at Jubilee House, the seat of Ghana's Presidency.

Deep throat sources indicate that The Peters Family Company Limited, the ultimate owner of the two front companies used to hide the COVID-19 testing at the airport might be linked to Controversial Nigerian billionaire, Benedict Peters a close friend of both President Nana Akuffo Addo and former Nigerian President Olusegun Obasanjo.

Benedict Peters, who is on a self-imposed exile in Ghana since 2018, has

been battling Nigeria's Economic and Financial Crimes Commission on allegations (EFCC)

Despite his wealth, Peters is somewhat of a controversial figure, smeared with several allegations of corruption, criminal conspiracy, bribery, diversion of funds and money laundering. He is alleged to be one of the individuals who linked to the infamous former Minister of Petroleum, Mrs. Diezani Alison-Maudeke who is still under investigation.

Whilst out of Nigeria in 2017, the country's Economic and Financial Crime Commission (EFCC) declared Peters wanted in respect of crimes they claim he committed together with

the infamous former Minister of Petroleum, Mrs. Alison-Maudeke, who is wanted in Nigeria but is currently held up in the UK where she is facing corruption charges.

After Peters was declared wanted, the EFCC placed their hand on the following properties belonging to the businessman:

- a) 58 Harley House, Marylebone Road, London worth 2,800,000 million pounds
- b) Apartment 4, 5, Arlington Street, London worth 11,800,000 million pounds
- c) Flat 5, 83-86, Prince Albert Road, London worth 3,750,000 million pounds
- d) Aiteo Energy Resources worth over \$4.023 billion.
- e) Account No 105277 in

FBN Bank (UK) in the name of Mr. B and Mrs. N. Peters

f) Funds in Account No 107127 in FBN Bank (UK) of Walworth Properties Ltd

g) The sum of 36,674.7 pounds held on behalf of defendant in the client Account of Clyde and Co. LLP, London

h) The sum of 40,620 pounds held in a correspondent Bank Account at Ghana International Bank, London

i) Shares in Walworth Properties Limited, Rosewood Investments and Colinwood Limited.

However, in 2018, a high court in Nigeria ordered Peters to be removed from the wanted list on a techni-



cal basis that the EFCC did not obtain a warrant before placing him on the list. The court also ordered the above properties to be returned to him. The EFCC had indicated that Peters was dodging them and hiding abroad, failing to appear before the anti-corruption body despite repeated summons.

After the EFCC removed his name from the list, he made Ghana his preferred home from where he is said to be operating his businesses.

"In July this year, we went to court to hear a case in which the former Minister has been summoned. The case has been adjourned until the 28 of October, 2020. Once we get hold of her, we shall finally talk about Peters," and EFCC source said last week.

In 2017, Mr Peters was sued in Nigeria for making a



donation of \$115 million to political parties in the 2015 general elections which insiders alleged was meant to bribe electoral officials.

One Chief Akinmoju sued the billionaire, alleging that he paid a bribe of \$115 million to electoral officers to influence the outcome of the 2015 Presidential elections.

Chief Akinmoju told the court that all of the electoral officers had made confession statements while their bank accounts had been frozen.

Aside the \$115 million, Peters was also accused of donating \$60 million to the PDP campaign fund, an amount the suit said was over the legal limit and a violation of the Nigeria Elections Act.

Peters admitted to the donation but denied that he had bribed electoral officers. He indicated in his affidavit that he has always made donations to political parties and that the money was not meant to be a bribe.

A High Court judge dismissed the suit against Peters, saying "the plaintiff

failed to show the court that the money was donated to influence the outcome of the 2015 Presidential elections."

AITEO GROUP

Peter Benedict is the owner of indigenous Nigerian Oil Giant AITEO. The company is owned by Nigerian billionaire Benedict Peters. AITEO is described as the largest indigenous oil producing firm in Nigeria by output. Peters' estimated net worth is said to be around US\$3 billion, making him the 5th richest man in Nigeria.

When the pandemic broke out in Nigeria, Peters donated \$30 million to the country's COVID19 fund and donated Zero to Ghana's COVID FUND.

FRONTIERS/PETERS AMPOFO/NANA ADDO

To begin with, Frontier Health Services is owned 100% by Healthcare Solutions Limited, a company which is, in turn, owned 100% by The Peters Family Company Limited, an opaque company registered in the notorious Caribbean Island tax haven called Dom-

inica. Whatsup News is confident that Peters Family Company Limited is owned by Nigerian billionaire businessman, Benedict Peters who is a close ally of former Nigerian President, Olusegun Obasanjo and President Nana Akufo Addo. Whatsup News has obtained evidential photographs to prove this connection.

Incidentally, the point man at the Noguchi Memorial Institute for Medical Research (NMIMR) who facilitated the entire deal to hand over the contract to charge each traveller to Ghana US\$ 150 each in the guise of a mandatory COVID-19 test, is a cousin to President Akufo Addo-Professor William Kwabena Ampofo.

Professor Ampofo is the Coordinator of the National Laboratory for COVID 19 Testing at Noguchi. This publication has obtained an August 27, 2020 letter addressed to Prof. Ampofo, from Frontier Healthcare Services "requesting for COVID-19 testing support at Kotoka International Airport". The letter was signed by Dr. Emmanuel Acquaye, purporting to be a Director at Frontier Healthcare Services.

In the letter, Frontier which was registered less than a month previously, (July 21, 2020) was requesting Prof. Ampofo's support to carry out their "Novel and first of its kind worldwide"

COVID-19 test on international travellers arriving Kotoka Airport.

Dr. Emmanuel Acquaye is a preacher and the Head Pastor for the Baastona Branch of Action Chapel International founded by Archbishop Duncan Williams. When contacted via telephone, Dr. Acquaye admitted that Professor Ampofo is his good friend, in what exposed a potential conflict of interest.

Essentially, the underhand dealers between the top hierarchy of Noguchi, the Akufo Addo administration and the Peters Family has not gone undetected as it also confirmed the earlier complaints by civil society groups and scientists from both Noguchi and elsewhere that the COVID-19 test being conducted at Kotoka was fraudulent because it is an Antigen test-which is one of the least accurate and cheap. Yet, Ghana was charging the highest price worldwide for the cheap test.

Also, it has emerged that the test by Frontier Healthcare Services has not undergone any clinical verification and thus cannot be considered safe to be used effectively on humans.

On Monday, Policy Think-tank IMANI Africa, having caught hint of the scandalous COVID-19 testing at KIA, raised red flags about the validity of the test.

"More alarmingly, our

sources are adamant that a "globally novel" biomedical intervention, as the Frontiers Healthcare product has been billed, cannot be used on humans without the approval of the Ethical Review authorities at the institution.



And yet, the Department of Virology has gone ahead to work with Frontiers Healthcare without any institutional review. What is going on here?" IMANI warned.

"The Health Institutions & Facilities Act of 2011 (Act 829) is very clear about the prerequisite for delivering clinical and biomedical laboratory services in this country: a company and its facilities have to be licensed by HEFRA - the Health Facilities Regulatory Agency of Ghana. Our checks reveal that at the time that Professor Ampofo oversaw the supposed validation processes for Frontiers Healthcare to begin making money, these approvals had not been secured."

Incidentally, Benedict Peters, the hidden owner of Frontier Healthcare Services is smeared with several allegations of corruption, criminal conspiracy, bribery, diversion of funds and mon-

ey laundering.

He is said to be one of the individuals who conspired with former Nigerian Minister of Petroleum, Mrs Diezani Alison-Maudeke, to misappropriate public funds.

In 2017, Nigeria's Eco-

nomics and Financial Crime Commission (EFCC) declared Peters wanted in respect to the alleged crimes committed in collaboration with disgraced Alison-Maudeke, who is wanted in Nigeria but is currently held up in the UK where she is facing corruption charges.

After his brush with EFCC, Peters did not return to Nigeria but went into self-imposed exile in Europe and also established a base in Ghana. According to intelligence gathered at Kotoka, Peters frequently fly into Accra in private jets and constantly uses the VIP Lounge at KIA, where he is treated as a king because of his connections with the higher government echelon in Ghana and the fact that he generously splashed money on airport staff.

A few years ago, One Chief Akinmoju had sued the billionaire, alleging that he paid a bribe of \$115 mil-

lion to electoral officers to influence the outcome of the 2015 Presidential elections. Chief Akinmoju told the court that all of the electoral officers had made confession statements while their bank accounts had been frozen. Aside the \$115 million, Peters was also accused of donating \$60 million to the PDP campaign fund, an amount the suit said was over the legal limit and a violation of the Nigeria Elections Act. Peters admitted to the donation but denied that he had bribed electoral officers.

Further investigations reveal that Frontiers Healthcare Services Ltd has just put up a website which has been flagged for copyright violations. Curiously, the website is managed by First Atlantic Bank and the bank based in Ghana purchased the domain name on August 27, 2020, for a year by an offshore company based in PANAMA.

Investigations that ties the complex web of shell companies together in the two notorious tax havens reveal that the largest shareholder for First Atlantic Bank is called Kedary Nominees, which owns 58% shares of First Atlantic Bank. Incidentally, Kedary Nominees is owned by AITEO, described as the largest indigenous oil-producing firm in Nigeria by output. AITEO is owned by Benedict Peters whose net worth is said to be around US\$3 billion, making him the 5th richest man in Nigeria.



TENSION BUILDS OVER EC REGISTER MESS

...MAHAMA CUTS CAMPAIGN SHORT TO FACE EC



The flagbearer of the opposition National Democratic Congress (NDC) and his running mate, ex-President John Dramani Mahama and Professor Jane Naana Opoku-Agyeman respectively, have cut short their campaign tour of Ghana to face the Electoral Commission (EC) following revelations that voters data captured in the new voters' register has been corrupted on the EC's system.

Insiders tell Whatsup News that at the current state, the register cannot be used for the December 2020 general elections, unless the data issued has been thoroughly addressed.

On his official Facebook page, John Mahama wrote: "I am cutting short my tour of the Bono Region to return to Accra because of the increasing reports of challenges

with the voter register and the exhibition process. We'll address a major press conference on the issues in due course."

The EC started its scheduled voter exhibition on September 18, 2020, for registered voters to confirm their details in the register, however, so far, thousands of people are complaining that their names have been hacked off the register.

The situation is gradually escalating civil agitations, particularly as it is emerging that most of the omissions are coming from strongholds of the NDC.

According to information gleaned by WhatsUp News from insiders that the major mess emerged when the EC attempted to transfer voter data onto its system. It was discovered that most of the data have been corrupted

and irretrievable, sources say.

Apparently, during the just-concluded new voters registration exercise, EC officials had been instructed to do offline registration on the Biometric Voters Register machines (BVR) with intent to transfer data into the EC's system later.

However, when the time came for the transfer to be effected, the EC's technicians realized that a lot of the data that had been captured offline had somehow been corrupted and made irretrievable.

In one Polling station, for instance, 2000 voters were registered, but 100 names were retrieved from the data transfer. This means that if nothing is done, over 1,800 people who registered at the centre will not be able to vote during the elections.

Earlier, the EC had hinted that the brand-new register was bloated with foreigners, and minors, and had appointed a committee to manually correct those alleged anomalies. However, critics fear that the election management body headed by Jean Adukwie Mensah was up to some foul play to facilitate the rigging of the forthcoming elections for the governing New Patriotic Party (NPP).

Investigative journalist, Kevin Ekow Taylor thinks that the entire situation is part of a grand agenda of the EC to rig the December 2020 elections for the ruling NPP.

It is believed that the EC has been forced to consider the possibility of reverting to the old register. However, the conundrum with this tentative decision is that Constitutional Instrument (CI) 94, which governed the 2016 elections has been amended by Parliament.

The amendment was what made way for CI 126 which is supposed to govern the 2016 elections.

Meanwhile, the new BVRs that the EC has brought into the country, are said to be only 5,000, a number that is very inadequate for the whole of the country which operates over 30,000 registration centres.

Should these reports be confirmed, the EC boss, Jean Adukwie Mensah would have wasted some GHC 443 million which was the budget for the new register that critics fruitless contested as needless.



SURVEY VERDICTS SHOWS MAHAMA BEATING AKUFO ADDO ON INFRASTRUCTURE



A survey report released today, September 22, 2020, has shown that the erstwhile administration of John Dramani Mahama has done way better in terms of infrastructure development in comparison to the current administration of President Akufo Addo, despite the fact that the latter had secured almost three times more funds than the Mahama administration.

The research was conducted by a Netherlands based group, AfricaWeb in collaboration with Ghanaweb, Ghana's biggest online news portal. It was aimed at bringing closure to the heated debate and public perception on which among the duopoly of the governing New Patriotic

Party (NPP) and the National Democratic Congress (NDC) have undertaken more infrastructural development in the country in their four-year term.

The polls were conducted online from a sample size of 2,055 people and it spanned one full month between July 1 and August 1, 2020. It was powered by GhanaWeb and the Africa Consumer Panel which is a cooperation between the digital publisher Africa Business Communities and renowned market research firm MSI-ACI.

The findings revealed that a significant 71% of Ghanaian adults believed that John Dramani Mahama has performed better compared to 27% of respondents who felt Nana

Akufo-Addo has a better record on infrastructure. The rest attributed a better track record on infrastructure to "other candidate".

A significant number of males and females (71% and 70% respectively) believe that John Dramani Mahama has a better track record on infrastructure as compared to 27% each for males and females who selected Nana Akufo-Addo.

From the research, it emerged that only youngsters between the age of 15 and 19 think the Akufo Addo-led NPP had performed better. However, this group form a small fraction of the general voting population.

From the survey, some 62% of Ghanaians who have no party affiliation credit John Mahama with a better

record on infrastructure as compared to 36% who credit Nana Akufo-Addo. 28% of Ghanaians who are NDC/Lean NDC credit John Mahama with a better record on infrastructure, while 59% of Ghanaians who are NPP/Lean NPP credit Nana Akufo-Addo with a better record on infrastructure.

John Mahama is generally considered as having a better track record on infrastructure across all regions, stated the survey report.

According to the report, the full sample of the survey has a margin of sampling error $\pm 2.162\%$. A representative sample of the Ghanaian population of 28,956,587 – population projection as stated on page 6 of the Ghana Living Standards Survey (GLSS 7) – was achieved by weighting (matching) the data according to age and gender demographics of the 2010 population and housing census and the GLSS 7.

The online poll is conducted every month and the results are published at the beginning of every other month on GhanaWeb.com. It is devoid of spam as the respondents can take the survey only once. The MSI-ACI platform that hosts the survey records the device on which the respondent takes the poll and does not allow for a second attempt from the same device.



JUBILEE HOUSE GALAMSEY DON AND AGYAPA KINGPIN IN BLOODY FIGHT



A violent turf war has erupted around the New Patriotic Party (NPP) Regional Secretary for Western Region, Charles Cromwell Bissie Member of Parliament for Tarkwa-Nsuem Constituency in the Western Region, George Mireku Duker. The confrontation reportedly escalated into blows and biting between the two.

Reports seen by Whatsup News indicates that there was a misunderstanding be-

tween the MP and the Regional party executive during a meeting in the Region. The misunderstanding reportedly escalated into a heated argument and a fight that reportedly saw Charles Bissie bite a chunk off the hands of Mireku Duker, who screamed amidst slaps aimed at his attacker.

According to sources indicated that George Mireku Duker and Charles have not been in good terms because the latter is supporting an indepen-

dent candidate against the incumbent.

According to on-line news portal, MyNewsGh.com which reported the incident, its reporters contacted Mireku Duker who confirmed the incident and said he had visited the hospital for treatment but declined to give further details.

"I have gone to the hospital and received treatment and I am getting well," Mireku Duker was quoted as saying.

Incidentally, these are two top appoin-

tees of the Akufo Addo administration who are at the centre of two major scandals in the administration.

Charles Bissie was caught on tape almost two years ago, receiving a huge payout for reportedly facilitating illegal gold mining activities, even though he was the Secretary to the inter-ministerial committee set up by President Akufo Addo to clamp down on illegal mining activities locally known as "Galamsey".

On the other hand, Mireku Duker is the Chairman of the Board of the Minerals Income Investment Fund (MIIF) which has controversially hatched a scheme that will funnel Ghana's mining royalties to Agyapa Royalties, a company registered in a notorious tax haven, and a company whose private shareholders have remained a mystery till date.



PROGRESSIVE CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION BOSS JABS PREZ AKUFO ADDO



Founder of the Progressive Contractors Association of Ghana, Mr. Kofi Owusu Akyaa, has character-sketches President Akufo-Addo as childish, traitorous.

In an interview on Kumasi based Otec FM, Mr. Akyaa accused the President of killing 22 contractors with his deliberate refusal to pay them for work done while all the time pretending that he is dealing well with contractors.

"...First and foremost, let me say that Akufo-Addo is beginning to become a very bad annoyance, be-

cause the lies that he has been telling are too many, they are unbecoming of him," Mr. Akyaa said when he was asked of his opinion about the President's promise that uncompleted roads will soon be attended to.

According to him, the promise is empty talk that contractors who have remained unpaid since Akufo-Addo became President almost four years ago, are all too familiar with.

"I remember during Kufuor's time, he said something that I will never forget...he said, the thing

(governance) when you are outside and observing, it is different from when you are in it, which is also different from when it depends on you. But as for this Nana, he is a typical rascal, Nana is a rascal. What I have seen about him is what I'm saying," Mr. Akyaa thundered.

The host of the show had tried to restrain the angry contractor, almost pleading with him to withdraw but Mr. Akyaa, who is also a man of God said he would not

"This 2.2 billion you mentioned, they have promised it over and over

again, they don't have any respect for us, they take us for children that they can hoodwink. You don't stay under God's skies and behave like that. Since they came, 22 contractors have died, and their deaths is on the heads of Nana Akufo-Addo and Amoako Atta," he said.

According to him, the 22 contractors died from melancholy and over-thinking because of the government's deliberate refusal to pay contractors.

"...many of them cannot be able to pay banks and cannot take care of their children. They become melancholic and die. I have advised Otumfuor to sack him (Akufo-Addo) from Kumasi, lest he ends up killing people of Kumasi."

Mr. Kofi Owusu Akyaa spoke in Asante Twi, lamenting that Kumasi, capital of Ashanti, has become so riddled with potholes that it is unbelievable. He called on Otumfour to show the Akufo-Addo government that Ashantis have men of substance who can take care of Kumasi, saying the Asantehene should forget about the "rascal" and his government.



KORLE-BU NURSES WALK OUT ON PATIENTS AS NPP ACTIVISTS CALLS THEM WITCHES



Nurses at the Korle-Bu Teaching Hospital today walked out on patients desperately in need of care in keeping with the nationwide strike declared by the Ghana Registered Nurses and Midwives Association (GRNMA).

GRNMA, begun an indefinite strike yesterday, Monday, September 21, 2020, to press home demands for better conditions

of service. Notice for the strike action had been given last Thursday after negotiations between government and the Nurses broke down.

Today at the Korle-bu teaching Hospital, patients who were snubbed by the Nurses included people on oxygen. People who were rushed to the emergency unit were told that they could not be cared for.

Nurses were seen

walking out of the Hospital to board vehicles home while stranded patients looked on helplessly. The OPDs were therefore mostly swarmed by patients without Nurses on hand to attend to patients.

Some of the stranded patients said they could not even have their cards processed because the records department of the hospital had no staff available to attend to them.

Meanwhile, an activist of the governing New Patriotic Party (NPP) has branded public sector Nurses and Midwives as witches for striking.

This sentiment is shared by many party members and appointees of the ruling party.

In a Facebook post, Rose Obeng, wrote that the action to press home better conditions of service from the Akufo-Addo government by the over 82,000 public sector Nurses is motivated by evil, cursing the Nurses that it is their relatives who will bear the brunt of their evil action.

"They can go to hell, no one will fall sick n die. During election year they go on strike, what improvements has increment on their salaries done to their lives? It's their own relatives that will visit the hospital during their absence," Ms Obeng wrote.



CHINESE SECRETLY COLONIZING GHANA THROUGH REAL ESTATE

...Atinka TV host

The host of a program on Accra based Atinka TV has raised an alarm over what he says is a gradual takeover of Ghanaian lands by Chinese in what appears to be a well calculated colonial project by means of real estate.

Bismarck Brown, host of "Si No Pi" tells of how Chinese are buying swathes of land in villages around the country in an ongoing invasion that escapes the attention of the country's leadership sitting in Accra.

"China is over-populated and its people are seeking new territories to possess and so there is this deliberate plan to buy lands and dispossess us the Ghanaian indigents and especially the future generation, of lands. The invasion is happening in the villages on the blind side of the authorities," Mr. Brown said in Twi.

According to him, he got wind of the ongoing invasion from a conversation with a Chinese man in Ghana. "he told me, "we are buying your lands in the villages," Bismarck Brown reported.

He called on President Akufo-Addo, the National Security apparatus and the Bureau of National Investi-



gations to probe the issue and do something about it.

According to him, the modus operandi of the Chinese is that they steal into the country and keep themselves in the villages, especially those along the borders. Consequently, they mostly do not enter through the country's airports. "They do not travel down to Accra, the Chinese doing these things love the villages because there they will have virtually no law enforcement officers to deal with," Bismarck Brown said.

He said, these Chinese come prepared with a lot

of money, claiming that because there is a national plan to de-populate China and possess new territories, there are Chinese banks which give out soft loans to nationals who travel to Africa to buy lands.

"Once they get to the villages, they settle there... they approach chiefs and buy large swathes of land," he said, adding, "do you know that when they buy the lands they take samples of the soil back to China to study it?"

While possessing Ghanaian lands through financial muscle, he said the Chinese are also deliberately trying

to deepen their legitimate claims to Ghanaian lands by impregnating village girls. "Our identity as Ghanaians is gradually getting missing; you go to the villages and there are many children who have "China" as suffixes to their Ghanaian names - Kwaku China..."

"The Chinese are over populated in their country and have taken a deliberate decision to depopulate. There are banks in China which are giving soft loans to people who want to travel to Africa. "It is a strategy to take new territories," he alleged.


